**Scholarship Fund Award Criteria**

The Roofing & Sheet Metal Contractors Association of Georgia, Inc. will grant a maximum \$1500.00 scholarship to full-time students and a maximum \$500.00 scholarship to part-time students, residing in the state of Georgia. Scholarships will be awarded to a student attending a two or four year accredited college.

**OBJECTIVE**

To develop qualified professionals, through education, for the benefit of the Roofing Industry.

**ELIGIBILITY**

All candidates must be:

1. High school seniors provisionally accepted as full or part-time students into undergraduate degree programs by an accredited two or four year college for the following fields of study: construction, engineering, architecture or business administration.

**OR**

Full-time or part-time students working toward an undergraduate degree at an accredited two or four year college in the following fields of study: construction, engineering, architecture or business.

2. United States citizens residing in the state of Georgia.

3. Employees or dependents of employees of a company that is eligible for regular membership in the Roofing & Sheet Metal Contractors Association of Georgia, Inc.

**ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

The following data are required from each candidate:

1. An official application form. A copy of the application form will not be accepted.
2. Two completed personal reference forms. The first should be completed by the guidance counselor at the educational institute most recently attended by the candidate. An optional letter of recommendation may also be included. An adult who is not related to the candidate and who is not a faculty member should complete the second.
3. An official transcript from all high schools and college attended.
4. Official ACT and/or SAT Test results.
5. Current photograph (to be used for publicity purposes only).

**AWARDS**

1. A maximum of \$1500.00 to be awarded yearly to full-time students and a maximum of \$500.00 to be awarded yearly to part-time students.
2. The scholarship will be sent for disbursement to the business administrator of the college or university whom the scholarship winner has chosen for his or her undergraduate studies.
3. For purposes of allocation, the scholarship funds are to be used with the following priorities: 1) tuition and fees, 2) textbook purchases, 3) room and board and other expenses.
4. Scholarship awards will be formally announced at Annual Convention.
